It's easy to be captivated by the laidback seaside town of Broome, known as the southern gateway to the Kimberley region.

No visit would be complete without spending some time on spectacular Cable Beach, 22 kilometres of pristine white sand lapped by the warm waters of the Indian Ocean. Witness a breathtaking Cable Beach sunset and take a camel ride along the beach, these are quintessential Broome experiences!

Broome's colourful pearling history has provided many of the town's attractions including the Japanese Cemetery and Chinatown, where pearl showrooms now line the streets. Catch a film at Sun Pictures, the oldest operating open air cinema in the world.

If you're lucky enough to be in town for the three days after the full moon from March to October each year, don't miss the Staircase to the Moon. This beautiful natural phenomenon is caused by the reflection of the rising full moon off the exposed mudflats.

Nearby Gantheaume Point has turquoise waters that meet striking red cliffs. Take a walk in 130 million year old dinosaur footprints at low tide or go on a four wheel drive adventure to remote Cape Leveque on the tip of the Dampier Peninsula. It's known for its Aboriginal heritage and dramatic coastal scenery.
