Visit underground museums and galleries, explore White Cliffs, maybe fossick for your own bit of opal. Travel to Mutawintji National Park, a place of dramatic scenery, prolific bird life, crystal clear rock pools and ancient Aboriginal art. Lunch in the national park before returning to Broken Hill. You will be transferred to the railway station. (BL)

All prices are based on a 24 hour rental period (e.g. pick-up 9am the first day; drop off 9am the next day). Any time over the 24 hour period will incur an additional charge.

EXCESS

An Excess of \$1,950 applies to drivers of all vehicles, with the exception of Groups K and W, which have an Excess of \$5,500. Optional Excess Reduction can be purchased direct for an additional fee of \$19.80 per day, or \$33 per day for Groups K and W. This fee reduces the Excess to \$330, or \$1,100 for Groups K and W.

MINIMUM AGE AND LICENCE REQUIREMENTS

The minimum age for drivers of vehicle groups X, A, B, C and D is 21 years. Drivers aged 21 to 24 years inclusive are required to pay a \$27.50 per day surcharge (to a maximum of \$192.50), which is payable directly to Avis at the time of rental. For all other vehicle groups, the minimum age for drivers is 25 years.

Drivers must hold an open licence and have held that licence for at least 12 months.
