Live the legend of the Goldfields with a visit to the Golden Outback. Call on your adventurous spirit and travel through eerie ghost towns and historic settlements. Kalgoorlie is the modern mining town renowned for its local characters, wild gold rush history and impressive heritage architecture. Explore the Super Pit Mine and see all the action. Head north to see the Gormley Sculptures – 51 steel figures that rise from the salt expanse at Lake Ballard.

Hit the tracks and take a journey through the Wheatbelt. Stop in at a country pub, wander the quaint streets and have a yarn with the locals. Head out near Hyden to take in Wave Rock, the massive rock formation believed to have taken 2,700 million years to form.

There's plenty of opportunity to get away from it all in the outback. Visit Murchison, the shire with no town, where just 15 people live among the sprawling stations. Explore Mt Augustus National Park, home to the largest rock in Australia. Then spend some time on a cattle station for the real outback experience.

Golfers travel from far and wide for the longest golf course in the world – the Nullarbor Links. Tee off in Kalgoorlie and play 18 holes over 1,365 kilometres to Ceduna, South Australia. With unique attractions, year round spectacular scenery and an explosion of wildflowers in spring, the Golden Outback never fails to impress.

For spectacular scenery alone, it's hard to go past Karijini National Park in the Pilbara region. See steep gorges, swim in cool rock pools and witness stunning waterfalls. An unforgettable outback experience.

Prospectors Golden Loop



Explore over 100 years of gold exploration with its successes and heartaches. Travel westward to Jack Carins' camp, this humble dwelling may look like story book stuff but even today you will find some old prospectors still living in these conditions.

At Coolgardie learn about Ernest Giles, documented as Western Australia's last explorer and Warden Finnerty's home, the man responsible for the signing of the Patrick Hannan claim in 1893. At the Coolgardie Museum Goldfields Exhibition, learn about Modesto Varischetti who was trapped underground for nine days in a flooded mine and then enjoy an historical tour of the town.

Continue on to Ora Banda via the Golden Quest Discovery trail and visit the ghost town of Kunanalling. Learn the history of Ora Banda and the story of the State Battery built in 1913, Grant's Patch and the Broad Arrow Hotel.

Coolgardie 'Mother of the Goldfields'



Step back in time and visit historic Coolgardie, birthplace of the Goldfields. Affectionately known as the 'Mother of the Goldfields' Coolgardie was once a booming gold town with magnificent buildings that were the pride of the outback in the early 1900s. A number of those buildings still stand today and are now home to the most outstanding collections of antique bottles, pharmaceutical items and mining memorabilia in Western Australia. Explore over 100 years of gold prospecting with its successes and heartaches. See Jack Carins' Camp, an original prospector's humble bush shack, the 'Entombed Miner' exhibition, a gold battery and Warden Finnerty's 1895 residence.

This fantastic day tour will deepen your appreciation of the hardships overcome by the prospectors of the day.

WORLD'S LONGEST GOLF COURSE



The Nullarbor Links golf course in Western Australia's Golden Outback has captured the imagination of the world. This unique 18 hole par 72 golf course spans 1,365 kilometres from Ceduna in South Australia to Kalgoorlie in Western Australia.

A single hole can be played in each participating town or roadhouse along the Eyre Highway, each featuring a green, a tee and a fairway of rugged outback natural terrain, this is a golfer's ultimate paradise.

Providing a quintessential Australian experience, the Nullarbor Links golf course is a unique attraction to the great Australian drive from east to west across the Nullarbor Plain. There is plenty to see along the way, including the longest stretch of straight sealed road in Australia, between Balladonia and Caiguna.

The course is clearly signposted, with golfing equipment available for hire at every tee. To play the course you can purchase a score card at Ceduna Visitor Information Centre, have your card stamped at each hole along the way then present your completed card at Kalgoorlie to receive your free 'You have played the World's Longest Golf Course' certificate.

SAMPLE SELF DRIVE ITINERARY - ADELAIDE TO PERTH

Day 1: Adelaide to Ceduna (785km) – play 2 holes at Ceduna.
Head north from Adelaide driving through the quaint coastal town of Port Pirie to Port Augusta at the head of the Spencer Gulf. Continue across the Eyre Peninsula through Iron Knob, synonymous with the birth of the Australian steel industry. Continue on to Ceduna, a beautiful seaside coastal town.

Day 2: Ceduna to Eucla (493km) – play 5 holes at Penong, Nundroo, Nullarbor, Border Village and Eucla.
Today, travel across the real Nullarbor Plain. Stop at head of Bight to observe the whales. Travel alongside coastal cliffs then cross the SA/WA border travelling to Eucla, a beautiful location with ocean views, on top of the escarpment. Be sure to visit the old telegraph station ruins.

Day 3: Eucla to Balladonia (513km) – play 5 holes at Mundrabilla, Madura, Cocklebiddy, Caiguna and Balladonia.
Leave Eucla by driving down the escarpment and travel along the Roe

Plains and through the scenic Madura Pass. Continue via Cocklebiddy and Caiguna to Balladonia.

Day 4: Balladonia to Kalgoorlie (394km) – play 6 holes at Fraser Range, Norseman, Kambalda and Kalgoorlie.
Balladonia is famous for the Skylab debris that crashed to earth around the area in 1979. Travel on via Fraser Range to Norseman, making sure to visit the Beacon Hill Lookout. Continue north to Kalgoorlie, Australia's largest gold producing city.

Day 5: Kalgoorlie to Perth (600km)
This morning, sightsee Kalgoorlie town and the Super Pit before heading off to Perth down the Great Eastern Highway. Along the way, travel through quaint townships such as Southern Cross, Merredin, Kellerberrin and Cunderdin before you arrive in Perth.
