

# Cooktown and Cape York



Twin Falls

Cape York Peninsula is truly Australia's last frontier – 115,000 square kilometres of wilderness and rainforest, sacred Aboriginal sites and rugged mountains that can't be seen anywhere else. Fish for Barramundi, get involved in turtle conservation or follow in the footsteps of Australia's early explorers.

Start in historic Cooktown, where you can join the locals for some world-class fishing, visit James Cook Museum and learn about the town's history. Immerse yourself in the Aboriginal culture by visiting one of the many Aboriginal ancient rock art sites around Cooktown and buying Aboriginal art from the locals. Witness a magnificent sunset from Grassy Hill before working your way to the mining town of Weipa.

Next on the itinerary are the small Aboriginal coastal communities of Bamaga and Seisia. Cross the Torres Strait and you're at Thursday Island, a three square kilometre patch of paradise. And of course, you can't miss standing on the tip of mainland Australia.

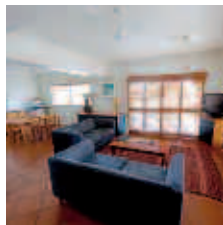

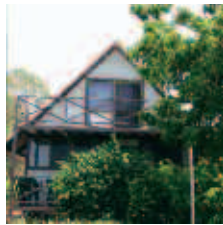
